Dr. Omar Serrano is Senior Lecturer and Researcher at the Global Studies Institute of the University of Geneva and a Guest Professor at Hunan University (湖南大学) as well as a regular lecturer at the University of Lucerne and the World Trade Institute in Bern. He has been part of the NCCR Trade Regulation and co-led several projects on emerging economies and global trade governance. Previously he worked at the Centre for Trade and Economic Integration. He is author of The Domestic Sources of European Foreign Policy: Defence and Enlargement and numerous scholarly articles looking at China and emerging economies' role in global trade governance. His current research looks at the transformation of international trade, investment and financial governance by emerging countries; especially China. He has held research fellowships in Beijing (UIBE), New Delhi (JNU), Mexico City (ITAM), Rio de Janeiro and São Paulo (FGV).

Omar studied political science and international economic relations at ITAM University in Mexico City and Global Politics at the London School of Economics and Political Science. He obtained his PhD in International Relations and Political Science at the Graduate Institute, Geneva. Since 2007, he has been an associate editor for the Chinese (Taiwan) Yearbook of International Law and Affairs. Having lived in both sides of the Atlantic helped him learn several languages which link directly to his current and previous research interests amongst which Spanish, German, French, Portuguese and Mandarin. In pursuing these interests, Omar has learned and applied both qualitative and quantitative methodologies: combining case study analysis, interview material, with regression analysis and fuzzy-set qualitative comparative analysis (fsQCA).
